Board Policy

Policy: Usage of Cell Phone/Electronic Devices
Effective Date: January 11, 2017

Developments in cell phone technology and other electronic devices have resulted in increased opportunities for communication. However, the usage of these devices during Parish School of Religion (PSR) class time results in class interruptions and, unfortunately, academic dishonesty.

The usage of electronic devices (including, but not limited to cell phones (calling, texting, web surfing), mp3 players, and gaming devices) is prohibited during PSR class times. The usage of an electronic device during class will result in the item being removed from the student by the catechist and given back to the student at the end of class. If a second infraction were to occur, the phone will be removed and taken to the PSR office. The CRE will be notified and a parent/guardian will be required to pick up the device from the office after the end of class.

In the event of an emergency, parents are asked to call the PSR office and not their child's cell phones.
