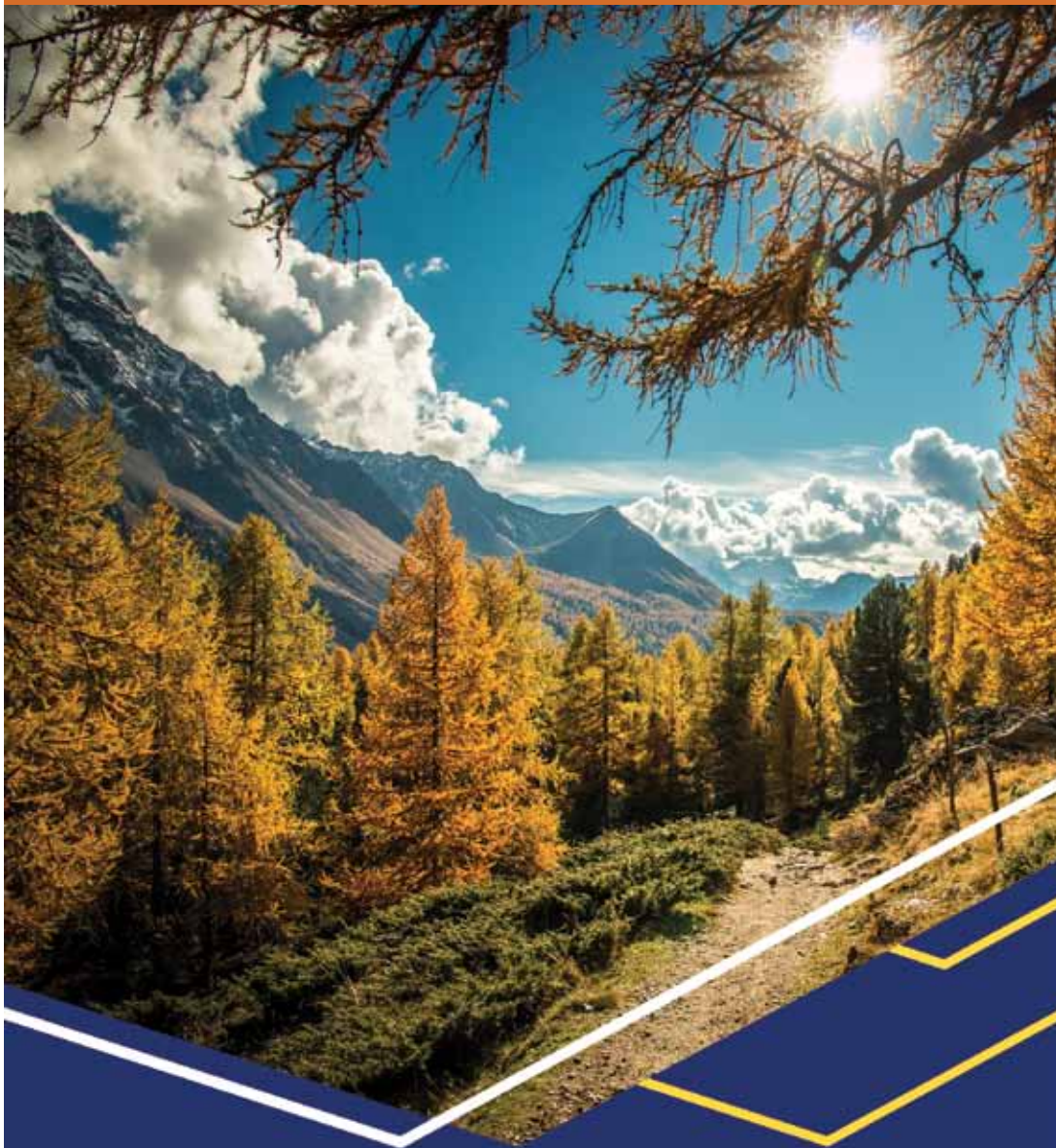

## **Most Sacred Heart “Spirit of Christmas” Program 2020**

A wonderful tradition at Most Sacred Heart is our annual Giving Tree “Spirit of Christmas” program. Once again we are humbly asking our parishioners to participate this year to allow those less fortunate than ourselves to have some things under the Christmas tree that would not be possible due to their circumstances.

However, like many things in this Coronavirus year, changes are required. We will not have trees in the back of church with paper gift ornaments on them. Instead, your shopping will be done online by St. Vincent de Paul Society members, to protect the anonymity of those we help and to allow a Covid-responsible method. The gifts will be sent directly to those in need, minimizing person to person contacts and insuring the safety of everyone involved.

Your very important role in this, if you are at all able, is to donate funds to St. Vincent de Paul this holiday season. Please consider donating what you would have spent on ornament presents, which will allow the Spirit of Christmas program to work. St. Vincent de Paul will use your funds to purchase gifts on your behalf.
